Summer Skip-A-Payment*

July OR August

Want extra cash for the summer?? You can skip-a-payment on your loans for July or August. There is a \$25 processing fee for each loan skipped. Skip-a-payments must be completed before payment is due.

Stop by the credit union to signup for skip-a-payment.

*There is a \$25 processing fee for each loan which may be deducted from your savings or checking account. Processing fees may not be added to the loan. Your loan must be at least six months old with a current payment status. Interest will continue to accrue and the skipped payment may cause the loan to extend beyond the scheduled payoff date. Excludes mortgage loans, home equity lines of credit, and visa. There is only one skip-a-pay available per year.
